Materials

Yardages based on 42" wide fabric

Choose fabric combos from the Stitch Cats collection to make pillowcase

White Stitch Cats Panel (Y2579-1)

White Cats (Y2580-1)

Dk Eggplant Cats (Y2580-46)

Red Cats (Y2580-82)

Emerald Cats (Y2580-107)

White Birds (Y2581-1)

Dk Taupe Birds (Y2581-63)

Dk Gold Birds (Y2581-69)

Lt Teal Birds (Y2581-103)

Taupe Plaid (Y2582-62)

Raspberry Plaid (Y2582-74)

Lt Teal Plaid (Y2582-103)

White Dots (Y2583-1)

Aqua Dots (Y2583-33)

Wine Dots (Y2583-48)

Emerald Dots (Y2583-107)

Fabric Requirements, Version A-(with Panel Cuff)

¾ yd or 1 Stitch Cats Panel (Y2579-1)

for Cuff Front

Fat Eighth for Cuff Back

Fat Quarter for Inner Cuff, Front & Back

3/4 yd for Pillowcase Body

Fabric Requirements, Version B

Fat Quarter for Cuff Front & Cuff Back

Fat Quarter for Inner Cuff, Front & Back

3/4 yd for Pillowcase Body

Optional: Fat Sixteenth for Contrast Sashing

Cut the Fabrics

WOF = Width of Fabric LOF = Length of Fabric

From the Outer Cuff front* cut:

1 piece 7" x 21"

From the Outer Cuff back cut:

1 piece 7" x 21"

From the Inner Cuff front cut:

1 piece 7" x 21"

From the Inner Cuff back cut:

1 piece 7" x 21"

From the Pillowcase body cut:

1 piece 25" x 41"

Optional Contrast Sashing:

1 piece 4" x 21"

*If cutting the Stitch Cats Panel Y2579-1 for the Outer Cuff front piece, center and cut a $7" \times 21"$ piece on the rectangular cat motif.

Directions

Prior to starting this project, please check our website for any updates: www.clothworks.com

All seams are sewn with a 1/2" seam unless otherwise indicated.

If using optional sashing - fold in half length wise, wrong sides together, and press.

Sew to cuff face using 1/411 seam.

Assemble Pillowcase

- 1. Sew Outer Cuff Front to Outer Cuff Back at one 7" side, right sides together.
- 2. Sew Inner Cuff Front to Inner Cuff Back at one 7" side, right sides together.
- 3. Sew Outer Cuff to Inner Cuff along the outside 41" side, right sides together
- 4. Sew the right side of the Inner Cuff piece (raw edge) to wrong side of pillowcase body
- 5. Turn inner cuff piece, fold over and press to outside of pillowcase body $\frac{1}{2}$ " and pin along stitch line. Stitch along seam line.
- 6. Right sides together, sew along cuff pieces matching seams, down along pillowcase body side and bottom, using ½" seam.
- 7. Turn right side out and you have a pretty pillowcase.
