WILD AND FREE PANEL QUILLY

FINISHED QUILT SIZE 58" x 51½"

Measurements include ¼" seam allowance.

Sew with right sides together unless otherwise stated.

Please check our website www.rileyblakedesigns.com for any revisions before starting this project. This pattern requires a basic knowledge of quilting techniques and terminology. The quilt and block diagrams portrayed are virtual images. The layout and look of your project may differ when using actual fabric.

WOF = Width of Fabric

RST = Right Sides Together

SNF = Stitch and Flip

FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

(1) Wild and Free Panel (P12938)

1/2 yard Blush Flower Toss (C12932)

1/2 yard Gold Flower Toss (C12932)

1/2 yard Seafoam Text (C12935)

½ yard Mint Clouds (C12934)

% yard Riley White Solid (C120)

½ yard Riley Baby Pink Solid (C120)

¾ yard Curry Solid (C120) for binding

OTHER SUPPLIES

Basic Sewing Supplies

3⅓ yards Backing

66" x 591/2" piece of Batting

CUTTING REQUIREMENTS

- Please read instructions before cutting fabrics.
- Cutting Instructions are based on a 42" WOF.
- Refer to the quilt photo for the placement of each of the fabrics.
- Use a straight edge ruler and rotary cutter to cut your fabrics.
- Label pieces as you cut.

Panel

Trim the panel to measure 42%" x 36" unfinished. Reference Page 3. Before trimming, ensure there will be at least a %" between the outermost panel illustrations and the trimmed edges of the panel.



Blush Flower Toss

Cut (1) 4½" x WOF; subcut (Cut carefully; yardage is exact.):

(4) 4½" squares

Cut (1) 2½" x WOF; subcut:

(16) 2½" squares

Cut (1) 21/2" x WOF; subcut:

(16) 2½" squares

Cut (4) 3½" x WOF; subcut:

(2) 3½" x 36" strips

Cut (3) 2½" x WOF; subcut:

(16) 2½" x 4 ½" rectangles



Cut (6) 21/2" x WOF for binding



STAR BLOCK ASSEMBLY

- 1. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (16) B squares and (16) C squares.
- 2. Place (1) B square onto the top left corner of (1) A rectangle, RST and edges aligned. Note the orientation of the drawn diagonal line in the diagram.
- 3. Sew along the drawn diagonal line. Trim excess corner fabric to a ¼". Press toward the corner.
- 4. Repeat SNF techniques to attach (1) C square to the top right corner of the same A rectangle to make (1) Flying Geese Unit. Unit should measure 4½" x 2½" unfinished.
- 5. Repeat to make (16) identical Flying Geese Units.



- 6. Arrange (4) Flying Geese Units with (4) D squares and (1) E square to form a Star Block.
- 7. Sew the pieces together. Press seams away from the Flying Geese Units. The Star Block should measure 8% x 8% unfinished.
- 8. Repeat to make (4) identical Star Blocks.



BORDER ASSEMBLY

- 9. Make the Side Borders. Sew (1) G strip to the side of (1) F strip lengthwise. Then, sew (1) H strip to the remaining side of the same F strip. Press seams toward the F strip. The Side Border should measure 36" x 8½" unfinished.
- 10. Repeat to make (2) Side Borders. (Please Note: For Side and Top/Bottom Borders, reference the cover quilt image for orientation of borders and the Mint Clouds print.)

- 11. Make the Top/Bottom Borders. Sew (1) J strip to the side of (1) I strip lengthwise. Then, sew (1) K strip to the remaining side of the same I strip. Press seams toward the I strip. The Top/Bottom Border should measure 42½" x 8½" unfinished.
- 12. Repeat to make (2) Top/Bottom Borders, referencing the note in Step 10.



QUILT ASSEMBLY

- 13. Arrange the Panel, Star Blocks, Side Borders and Top/Bottom Borders as shown in the diagram to form the quilt top.
- 14. Sew (1) Side Border to both sides of the Panel. It is recommended to use pins to avoid shifting or stretching. Press toward the Side Borders. The quilt top should meausure 58½" x 36" unfinished at this step.
- 15. Sew (1) Star Block to both ends of each Top/Bottom Border. Press away from Star Blocks. Top/Bottom Borders should now measure 58½" x 8½" unfinished.
- 16. Sew (1) Top/Bottom Border to the top and bottom of the quilt top, using pins to align and nestle seams. Press toward the Panel. The completed quilt top should measure 58½" x 52" unfinished.





FINISHING THE QUILT

17. Finish your quilt by layering the quilt top, batting and backing. Quilt as desired. Bind with (6) 2½" x WOF Curry Solid strips.
