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NOEL PANEL

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Holly, pinecones, reindeer—all in a beautiful stenciled-look panel! Janet surrounded the panel with easy-fuse Noel trees, and the result is a stunning winter quilt that can be made in a weekend. Want an extra cozy touch? back it with *Minkee Blankee!* Finished Size: 44-1/2" x 51".

Benartex
Fabric for quilters. By quilters.

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NOTE: STEPS 4 AND 5 REQUIRE FUSIBLE WEB.

- 1 Begin by cutting **Noel Panel A** down to 22" x 40-1/2".
- 2 Take (2) 2" x 40-1/2" **B** strips and add each to sides of panel.
- 3 Take (2) 2" x 25" **B** strips and add each to top and bottom. Trim. You will need the leftover strips for Step 7.
- 4 Inner border take (8) fused **G** 5-1/4" x 5-1/2" blocks and fold in half on the 5-1/4" length. Draw a diagonal line from top left to bottom right. Cut on line. Line up **G** and **D** bottoms and iron with fusible web.



LEAVE 1/4" FROM TOP



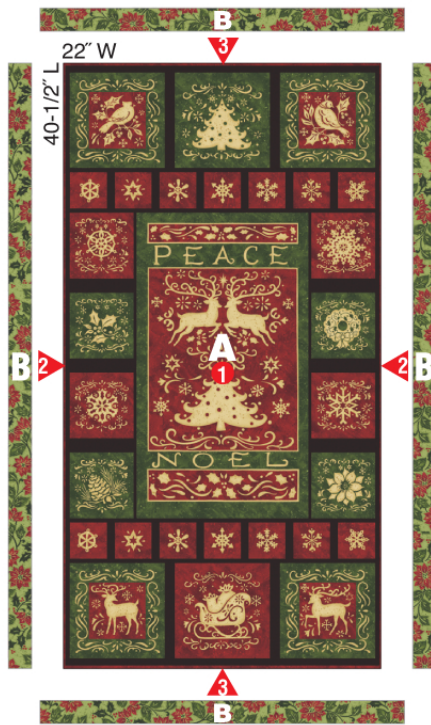
- 5 Using the same method, make 4 each of the following **EH** and **FH** squares.



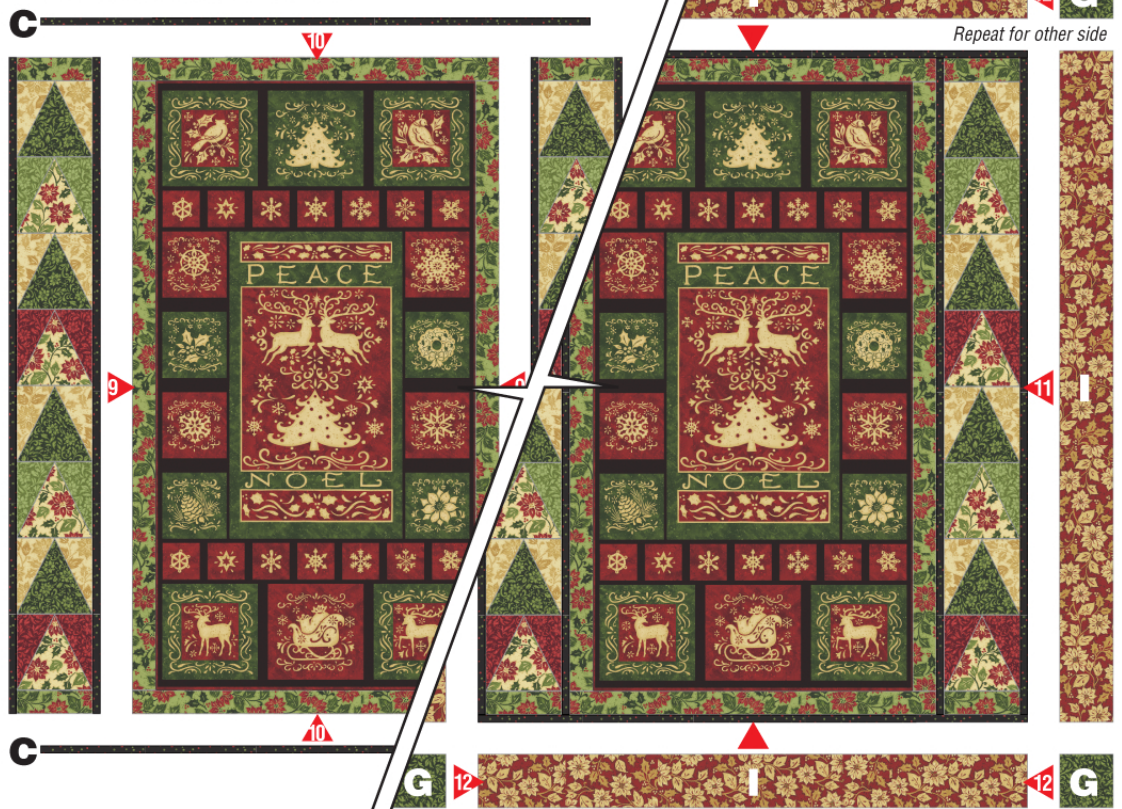
- 6 Attach squares as shown at right. Make 2 inner border units.



- 7 From your leftover **B** strips in Step 3, cut (4) 2" x 5-1/2" rectangles. Add to top and bottom of each inner border unit.
- 8 Measure length of the 2 inner border units (ours was 43-1/2"). Sew short ends of (5) **C** strips, then cut (4) 44" strips. Take 2 of these strips and sew to sides of each inner border unit.



- 9 As shown below, attach inner border units to sides of panel unit.
- 10 Measure the width of the quilt top (ours was 37-1/2"). Take (2) 1-1/4" x WOF **C** strips and trim to 38". Sew these strips and to the top and bottom as shown below.



- 11 The outer borders will have to be pieced. As shown above right, sew short ends of (2) 4" x WOF **I** strips together. Attach to quilt side. Trim to fit. Repeat for other side.
- 12 Measure quilt top width without side borders **I** (ours was 37-1/2"). Take (2) 4" x WOF **I** strips and trim to 38". Attach (2) 4" **G** squares to each end of the **I** strips. Sew these outer border units to the top and bottom.

- 13 Cut batting and backing 3" larger than quilt on all sides. Make a sandwich by layering backing, batting and top. Baste or pin with safety pins. Machine quilt as desired. Trim excess. Bind in usual manner.

I		Poinsettia 3611-11 Red/Gold	2/3 YD	(5) 4" x WOF strips.
J		Brushed Texture 3615-11 Red	1/2 YD	Binding
