

Instructions


1. Sew two matching C strips to the top and bottom of an A square. Press toward the strips.




2. Sew two matching D strips to the sides of the Step 1 unit. Press toward the strips. At this point your block should measure 8½" square.



- 3. Repeat Steps 1 and 2 for all the A squares. You should have 10 total units.
- 4. Sew two D strips to the top and bottom of a Step 3 unit. The D strips should match each other but not the Step 3 unit strips. Press toward the strips.



5. Sew two matching E strips to the sides of the Step 4 unit. Press toward the strips. At this point your block should measure 12½" square.



- 6. Repeat Steps 4 and 5 for all the Step 3 units. You should have 10 blocks.
- 7. Sew two matching D strips to the sides of a B square. Press toward the strips.



8. Sew two matching E strips to the top and bottom of the Step 7 unit. Press toward the strips. At this point your block should measure 12½" square.




9. Repeat Steps 7 and 8 for all the B squares. You should have 10 total blocks.

Before sewing rows together, you can layout all your blocks and arrange them to your liking.


10. Starting with a Step 6 block, make a row with two Step 6 blocks and two Step 9 blocks, alternating the Step 6 and Step 9 blocks. Press to the right. Make 3 rows.



11. Starting with a Step 9 block, make a row with four blocks, alternating Step 9 and Step 6 blocks. Press to the left. Make 2 rows.



12. Sew all 5 rows together, starting with a Step 10 row and alternating Step 10 and Step 11 rows. Pin the rows together, lining up the intersections before sewing.



- 13. Layer the backing (wrong side up), batting and quilt top (right side up). Baste layers to secure.
- 14. Quilt as desired.
- 15. Trim the backing and batting flush with the quilt top. Bind the edges using a 3/8" wide seam allowance.
