(2) $18^{\prime \prime} \times 18^{\prime \prime}$ Batting

## GIFT BLOCK ASSEMBLY

1. Sew (1) $\mathbf{H}$ rectangle to each side of (1) $\mathbf{L}$ rectangle. Sew (1) I rectangle to each side of (1) $\mathbf{M}$ rectangle. Gift unit should measure $4-5 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ raw edge to raw edge.

2. Sew the $\mathbf{L}$ and $\mathbf{M}$ bows to the edges of the $\mathbf{K}$ background pieces to make bow.
3. Sew (1) $\mathbf{K} 1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares to the ends of the bow. Bow unit should measure $4-5 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ raw edge to raw edge.
4. Sew the bow unit to the top of the gift unit to make the gift.
5. Sew (1) $\mathbf{K}$ triangle to each side of the gift. Make 2 with triangles and 2 with triangles reversed. Block should measure 5-1/2"

## STAR BLOCK ASSEMBLY

1. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (32) I 1-1/4" squares using a marking pen.
make 32
2. Pin (1) I squares to one end of (1) $\mathbf{N}$ rectangle. Sew along the drawn line. Trim the fabric $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ from the stitching as indicated by
 the solid line. Fold the I piece over the seam allowance and press.
3. Sew another I square to the other end of the $\mathbf{N}$ rectangle, trim and press in the same manner to make each star point unit.

5. Sew a star point unit to opposite edges of a (1) J 2" squares to make star center unit.

6. Sew (1) $\mathbf{N} 1-1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ square to each end of the remaining star point units.

7. Sew (2) star point units to the edge of the star center unit. Star block should measure $3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ raw edge to raw edge

## PATCHWORK BORDER

8. Patchwork Border A: Take (15) $3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 35 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles and sew together along 3-1/2" edges as shown in diagram. Make (2) Patchwork Border - A. NOTE: Use slightly less than $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ seam allowance for a few seams. Patchwork Borders should measure $3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 47-3 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ raw edge to raw edge.

9. Patchwork Border B: Take (13) $3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares and sew together as shown in diagram. Sew star blocks to the ends. Make 2 Square Border - B. Borders should measure 3-1/2" x 45-1/2" raw edge to raw edge.

## QUILT TOP ASSEMBLY

Follow quilt top layout diagram on page 6.
10. D BORDER: Take (1) D 2-1/2" $\times 31-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ border and sew to long sides of A 23-1/2" $\times 31-1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ Panel. Sew (2) I 2-1/2" square to ends of (2) D 2-1/2" $\times 23-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ borders. Then sew borders with squares to top and to bottom of A Panel.
11. B BORDER: Take (1) B $5-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 35-1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ border and sew to long sides of $\mathbf{D}$ border. Sew present blocks to ends of (2) B 5-1/2" $\times 27-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ borders. Then sew borders with blocks to top and to bottom of D Border.
12. D BORDER: Sew the ends of the (4) D $1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips together. Cut (2) $1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 45-1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ borders and (2) 1-1/2" x 39-1/2" borders. Sew the 1-1/2" x $45-1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ borders to the long sides of B border. Then sew the $1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 39-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ borders to top and bottom edges of $\boldsymbol{B}$ border.
13. PATCHWORK BORDER: Sew Patchwork Border A to long sides of $\mathbf{D}$ border. Then sew Patchwork Border B to top and to bottom of $\mathbf{D}$ border.

FINISHING: Layer quilt top, batting and backing together to form quilt sandwich. Baste and quilt as desired. Bind using I 2-1/4" strips.

## PILLOWS

## STAR BLOCKS

1. Make star blocks following the instructions for the quilt using I 1-1/2" squares, J 1" squares and N 1" squares and $1^{\prime \prime} \times 1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles.
Finished block measures $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square raw edge to raw edge. Make 8 blocks.

2. Patchwork Border A: Arrange (5) 2-1/2"squares for each border. Sew together as shown.
NOTE: Use slightly less than $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ seam allowance so finished strip measures $10-3 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$.

3. Patchwork Border B: Take (5) $2-3 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares and sew together as along the $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ edges. NOTE: Use slightly larger than $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ seam allowance so finished strip measures 11-1/4" $\times 2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$.
Sew (1) star block to each end of the patchwork strip.

4. Sew (1) Patchwork Border A to sides of each panel. Sew (1) Patchwork Border B to top and bottom edges of each panel.


FINISHING: Trim batting and backing 1/4" larger than pillow top. Layer pillow tops, batting pieces and backings together to form quilt sandwiches. Baste and quilt as desired. Sew ends of I bias strips together. Make cording using bias strip and sew around pillow top and finish pillow using your favorite method.
