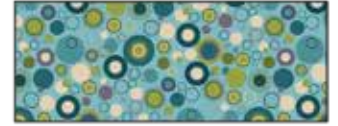

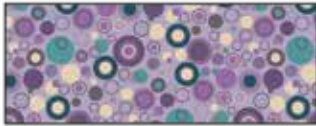

Cutting Instructions (Both Versions)

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the Banner Panel - Navy (A):

- Fussy cut (12) 6" x 8 1/2" rectangles, each centered on a gnome.

From the Plaid - Navy (B), cut:

- (1) 2 7/8" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 2 7/8" squares.
- (1) 1 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 1 1/2" x 8 1/2" strips.
- (1) 1 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 1 1/2" x 6" strips.
- (5) 2 1/2" x WOF strips for the Version 1 binding or (7) 2 1/2" x WOF strips for Version 2 binding.

From the Starry Basics - Teal (C), cut:

- (1) 2 7/8" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 2 7/8" squares.
- (1) 1 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 1 1/2" x 8 1/2" strips and (2) 1 1/2" x 6" strips.

From the Floral - Red (D), cut:

- (1) 2 7/8" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 2 7/8" squares.
- (1) 1 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 1 1/2" x 8 1/2" strips.
- (1) 1 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 1 1/2" x 6" strips.

From the Houndstooth Basics - Rose (E), cut:

- (1) 2 7/8" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 2 7/8" squares.
- (1) 1 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 1 1/2" x 8 1/2" strips and (2) 1 1/2" x 6" strips.

From the Plaid - Green (F), cut:

- (1) 2 7/8" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 2 7/8" squares.
- (1) 1 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 1 1/2" x 8 1/2" strips.
- (1) 1 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 1 1/2" x 6" strips.

From the Starry Basics - Gold (G), cut:

- (1) 2 7/8" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 2 7/8" squares.
- (1) 1 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 1 1/2" x 8 1/2" strips and (2) 1 1/2" x 6" strips.

From the Plaid - Rose (H), cut:

- (1) 2 7/8" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 2 7/8" squares.
- (1) 1 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 1 1/2" x 8 1/2" strips and (2) 1 1/2" x 6" strips.

From the Houndstooth Basics - Green (I), cut:

- (1) 2 7/8" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 2 7/8" squares.
- (1) 1 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 1 1/2" x 8 1/2" strips and (2) 1 1/2" x 6" strips.

From the Floral - White (J), cut:

- (1) 2 7/8" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 2 7/8" squares.
- (1) 1 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 1 1/2" x 8 1/2" strips and (2) 1 1/2" x 6" strips.

Cutting Instructions (Both Versions) - Continued

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage unless otherwise noted.

From the Starry Basics - Muted Purple (K), cut:

- (1) 2 7/8" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 2 7/8" squares.
- (1) 1 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 1 1/2" x 8 1/2" strips and (2) 1 1/2" x 6" strips.

From the Bubble Dot - Blue (L), cut:

- (1) 2 7/8" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 2 7/8" squares.
- (1) 1 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 1 1/2" x 8 1/2" strips and (2) 1 1/2" x 6" strips.

From the Houndstooth Basics - Brown (M), cut:

- (1) 2 7/8" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 2 7/8" squares.
- (1) 1 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 1 1/2" x 8 1/2" strips and (2) 1 1/2" x 6" strips.

From the Starry Basics - Red (N), cut:

- (1) 2 7/8" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 2 7/8" squares.
- (1) 1 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 1 1/2" x 8 1/2" strips and (2) 1 1/2" x 6" strips.

From the Gnomes Tossed Allover - Yellow (O), cut:

- (1) 2 7/8" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 2 7/8" squares.
- (1) 1 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 1 1/2" x 8 1/2" strips and (2) 1 1/2" x 6" strips.

From the Houndstooth Basics - Light Teal (P), cut:

- (1) 2 7/8" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 2 7/8" squares.
- (1) 1 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 1 1/2" x 8 1/2" strips and (2) 1 1/2" x 6" strips.

From the Starry Basics - Green (Q), cut:

- (1) 2 7/8" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 2 7/8" squares.
- (1) 1 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 1 1/2" x 8 1/2" strips and (2) 1 1/2" x 6" strips.

From the Bubble Dot - Purple (R), cut:

- (1) 2 7/8" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 2 7/8" squares.
- (1) 1 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 1 1/2" x 8 1/2" strips and (2) 1 1/2" x 6" strips.

From the Houndstooth Basics - New Teal (S), cut:

- (1) 2 7/8" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 2 7/8" squares.
- (1) 1 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 1 1/2" x 8 1/2" strips and (2) 1 1/2" x 6" strips.

From the House Tossed Allover - Blue (T), cut:

- (2) 3" x 48 1/2" Length of Fabric (LOF) strips.
- From the remaining fabric, cut (2) 3" x 34" WOF strips, piece as needed, (2) 2 7/8" squares, (2) 1 1/2" x 8 1/2" strips and (2) 1 1/2" x 6" strips.

From the Starry Basics - Brown (U), cut:

- (1) 2 7/8" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 2 7/8" squares.
- (1) 1 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 1 1/2" x 8 1/2" strips and (2) 1 1/2" x 6" strips.

From the Houndstooth Basics - Red (V), cut:

- (1) 2 7/8" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 2 7/8" squares.
- (1) 1 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 1 1/2" x 8 1/2" strips and (2) 1 1/2" x 6" strips.

Version #2 ONLY

From the Border Stripe - Teal (W), cut:

- (2) 10" x 76" LOF strips.
- (2) 10" x 57" LOF strips.

From the House Tossed Allover - White (Backing), cut:

Version #1

- (1) 42" x 61" LOF strip for the backing.

Version #2

- (2) 80" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 61" x 80" back.

Block Assembly

Note: The arrows in figures represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components. Use a 1/4" seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted.

- Place (1) 2 7/8" Fabric B square on top of (1) 2 7/8" Fabric C square, right sides together. Draw a line across the diagonal of the top square (Fig. 1). Sew 1/4" away from each side of the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 1). Cut the (2) squares apart on the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 2) to make (2) half-square triangles. Trim the half-square triangles to measure 2 1/2" square to make (2) Unit 1 squares (Fig. 3). Repeat to make (4) Unit 1 squares total.

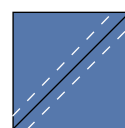

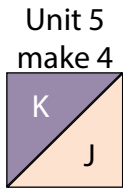

3. Sew (1) 1 1/2" x 8 1/2" Fabric C strip to the left side of (1) 1 1/2" x 8 1/2" Fabric B strip lengthwise to make (1) Unit 13 strip (Fig. 15). Repeat to make a second Unit 13 strip.

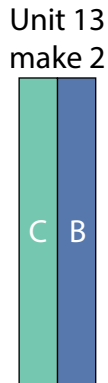

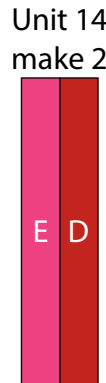

4. Repeat Step 3 and refer to Figures 16-26 for fabric identification and placement to make (2) of each unit strip for Unit 14 through Unit 24.

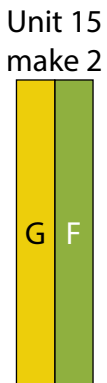

5. Sew (1) 1 1/2" x 6" Fabric C strip to the top of (1) 1 1/2" x 6" Fabric B strip lengthwise to make (1) Unit 25 strip (Fig. 27). Repeat to make a second Unit 25 strip.

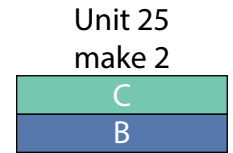

6. Repeat Step 5 and refer to Figures 28-38 for fabric identification and placement to make (2) of each unit strip for Unit 26 through Unit 36.

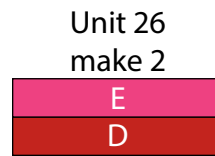

Quilt 1

7. Sew (1) Unit 1 square to each end of (1) Unit 25 strip to make the top row. Repeat to make the bottom row. Sew (1) Unit 13 strip to each side of (1) 6" x 8 1/2" Fabric A rectangle to make the middle row. Sew the (3) rows together to make (1) Block One rectangle (Fig. 39).

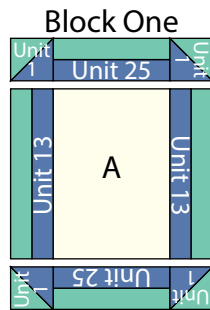

8. Repeat Step 7 and refer to Figures 40-50 for component identification, placement and orientation to make (1) of each block rectangle for Block Two through Block Twelve.

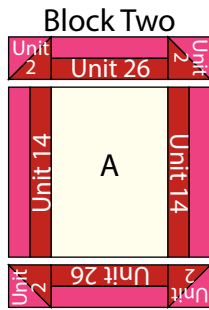

9. Follow Figure 51 and sew together the (12) rectangles, in numerical order, into a 3 x 4 matrix to make the Center Block.

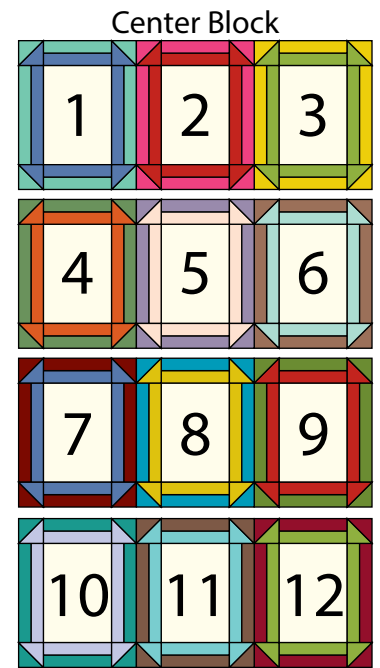

Quilt Top Assembly

(Follow the appropriate Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.)

10. Sew (1) 3" x 48 1/2" Fabric T strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 3" x 34" Fabric T strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make Quilt Top Version #1.

Quilt Top Version #2 only:

11. Center (1) 10" x 76" Fabric W strip on (1) side of the Center Block and pin in place. Start sewing the strip a 1/4" from the top edge of the block and stop a 1/4" from the bottom edge. **DO NOT TRIM THE EXCESS.** Repeat with the opposite side.

12. Repeat Step 11 to sew (1) 10" x 57" Fabric W strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block, making sure to stop and start ¼" away from each end of the block. To miter each corner, fold the Center Block on a diagonal, wrong side together. This should line up the strips from adjacent sides (Fig. 52).

13. Starting at the sewn seam (represented by the arrow in Figure 52), draw a 45-degree line to the edge of the fabric. Sew on the drawn line. Trim the excess fabric leaving a ¼" seam. Repeat this step with the remaining corners to make Quilt Top Version #2.

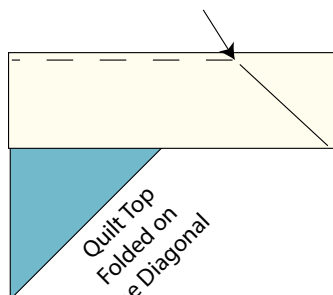
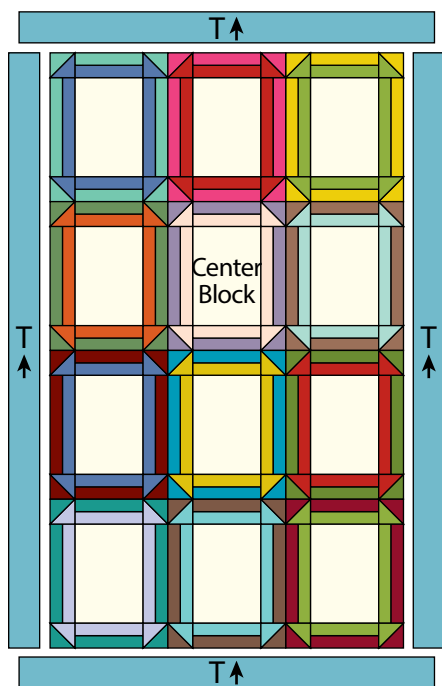

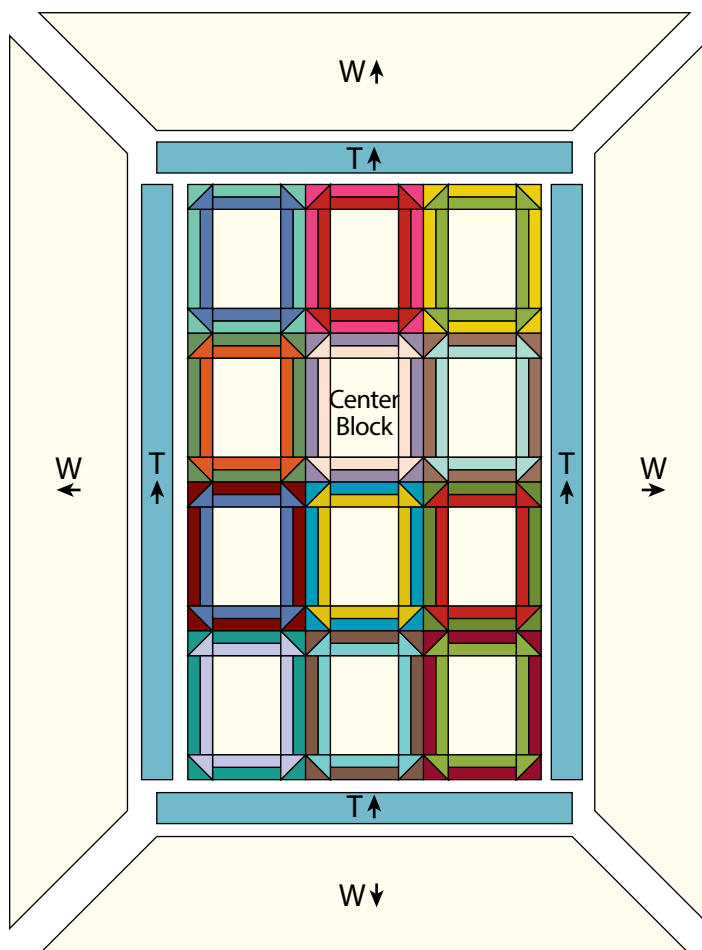
14. Layer and quilt as desired.

15. Sew the (5) 2 ½" x WOF Fabric B strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding for Version #1 or (7) 2 ½" x WOF Fabric B strips for Version #2. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.

16. Bind as desired.
